

November Bike Club Minutes – November 9, 2022

- Meeting called to order by Kerrie Johnson – approximately 60 members in attendance
- New Members: Beck Ettien
- October minutes were reviewed and approved.
- Treasurer's report given by Joe Marinello - \$1,418.18 in the bank – approved.
- Election: Lori explained that the rec center has an online voting system that will be used by our club. The voting is active from today until Friday, 11-11, until 3:00 pm. All members received an email with a link to the voting site. Alan Schlemmer, who was running for VP, stood up and withdrew his name from running, which puts Carlos as the only contender.
- Spring Trip: Being organized by Carlos and Richard – Palm Springs, 2-19-23/2-22-23. Carlos handed out a sheet for members to add their name if they are interested. It isn't the official signup, is only to give Carlos and Richard an idea of how many may go so they can attempt to block out hotel rooms. Once it is finalized, they will need volunteers for organizing rides, dinners, and activities for non-riders.
- Ringing the Bells: Alan will complete this commitment, it will be on December 11th at Fry's, Safeway and Basha's. He does have some slots left, but the date is still not confirmed as no one from the Salvation Army has returned his phone calls.
- Bikes for Kids: Alan will complete this commitment, to date he has \$1,514 in donations. He needs any further donations ASAP as he is finding a shortage in inventory.
- Trivia Hunt Ride: Alan is organizing this ride, is on Saturday, 11-12. It will be about 14 miles, is leisurely. Will meet at Echo Mesa at 8:15.
- Safety: Jeff Bodmer expressed the need for bikes to have mirrors and lights for safety reasons. There are plenty of close calls in SCW, and in the surrounding community. Stressed the need to ride single file, stop at stop signs, and watch for police in SCG. If any members find dangerous road conditions in SCW, let Jeff know – he will pass it along to his quarterly PORA meetings.
- Saturday morning breakfast ride: Kerrie organized the one in October.
- Christmas Party: Organized by Anne Brown and Lori Schroeder – cost is \$18 per bike club member, and is \$24 for non-members. Memo's will be catering it – it is a BYOB, a signup sheet was sent around to volunteer for desserts, cleanup, setup, decorating and staffing the welcome table. The party is on 12-4, doors open at 5:00.
- Karaoke Night: Jeff Goldstein works at the Mule Creek Saloon, and has a karaoke machine. He has offered having a bike club karaoke night starting at 5:00. Kathy will look into making this a January bike club dinner.
- The club needs someone who will take over the ordering/handling of SCW bike clothing/gear. Richard has been doing it too long.
- SCW Club Expo: is today at the Social Hall – various members are staffing the bike club table.
- Name tags: these can be ordered from Ed Johnson, cost is \$7 each.
- Meeting brought to a close and was approved.
